

# Anti-litter Policy



## Principles

School ABC believes that all members of the school community have the right to learn, work and socialise in a clean, safe and happy environment.

## Aims

- The school strives to be a litter free environment.
- The school will teach respect for the environment.
- The school will try to reduce, reuse and recycle when possible as means to reducing litter.
- The school will try to support these above aims beyond the school gate and into local the community.
- The school believes all members of the school community have the right to suggest ways to improve the school environment.

## Responsibilities

All members of the school community have a responsibility to:

- To reduce waste and recycle where possible.
- To pick up litter if lying around.

All staff members have the responsibility to:

- Support pupils in their efforts to deal with litter problems.
- Ensure that eliminating litter remains a high-profile agenda item.

The school caretaker has the responsibility to:

- Co-ordinate safe waste disposal from the site.
- To assist in maintaining a clean site.
- Empty waste bins.

The Eco Committee has the responsibility to:

- Monitor and report on the litter situation.
- To listen and respond to suggestions from the school community.
- To promote anti-litter messages across the school.
