To help us achieve this, we have developed the Long Forest App which allows you to easily survey hedgerows across Wales. This app allows you to survey the hedgerows across Wales and help gain vital information about the condition and species makeup of the hedgerows.

Our app had been designed by app developers Natural Appitude, who have had a wealth of experience in wildlife recording apps. We designed the app to be accessible to different types of experience and can be used in all areas of Wales even without mobile phone signal.

What phones are compatible with the Long Forest app?

The Long Forest app is available to download on all iphones and Android devices.

How much does the Long Forest app cost to download?

The Long Forest app is free to download and has no cost associated with using it. The app was developed by Keep Wales Tidy with funding from the Heritage Lottery fund and Esmee Fairbairn Foundation as part of the Long Forest Project.

Why did Keep Wales Tidy develop the Long Forest app?

Keep Wales Tidy does a huge amount of environmental work throughout Wales and is particularly active with communities across Wales to improve their communities. Keep Wales Tidy developed the Long Forest app in partnership with the Woodland Trust as part of the Long Forest project to increase our records on the state of our Welsh hedgerows.

Will the Long Forest app stop working when I'm out of mobile reception or Wi-Fi?

No. The Long Forest app must be downloaded in an area of internet connectivity, but from that point it will not need phone connection or Wi-Fi to work.
